The Florida Association for the Education of Young Children's State Legislative priorities:

- 1. Support adequate funding to provide Florida's young children with a safe and high quality early childhood education that includes a developmentally appropriate curriculum tied to State Standards and authentic assessment measures.**

In order to assure Florida's families of high quality early care and education programs, funding cannot be continually diminished.

- 2. Support Early Childhood Professionals with a career ladder, leading to a degreed lead teacher in each classroom with adequate compensation.**

A system needs to be in place that will attract and retain high quality educators at the critical stage of early brain development to enable future school success.

- 3. Support local initiatives that promote high quality in early childhood programs benefiting Florida's children.**
