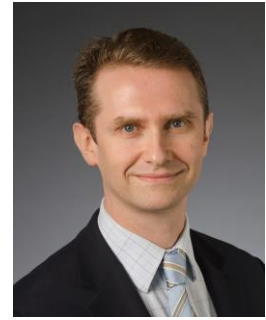


# FLAEYC Pre-Conference Special Event

FLAEYC has partnered with the Children's Forum to offer the **2018 Leadership Summit: Compassion to Action**.

This full-day **Pre-Conference Special Event** will provide participants the opportunity to learn and share together.

The day will start with a keynote presentation from Dr. Walter Gilliam of the Edward Zigler Center in Child Development and Social Policy at Yale University. Dr. Gilliam will share evidence-based strategies for improving the quality of early care and education services. He will discuss effective methods to reduce classroom behavior problems and preschool expulsion.

The afternoon will feature an expert panel discussing issues such as trauma-informed care, adult well-being, emergency preparedness, and diversity awareness, followed by breakout sessions to explore these trending topics in greater detail.

Learning Objectives for the **2018 Leadership Summit** include the following:

- Upon completion of the Leadership Summit, participants will be able to identify signs of classroom behavioral issues and equipped with the skills and knowledge to properly assess and address these issues.
- Upon completion of the Leadership Summit, participants will be able to explain the principles of trauma-informed care and apply them in necessary work and/or personal situations.
- Upon completion of the Leadership Summit, participants will create an action plan for their personal well-being and addressing emergency preparedness in the classroom.
