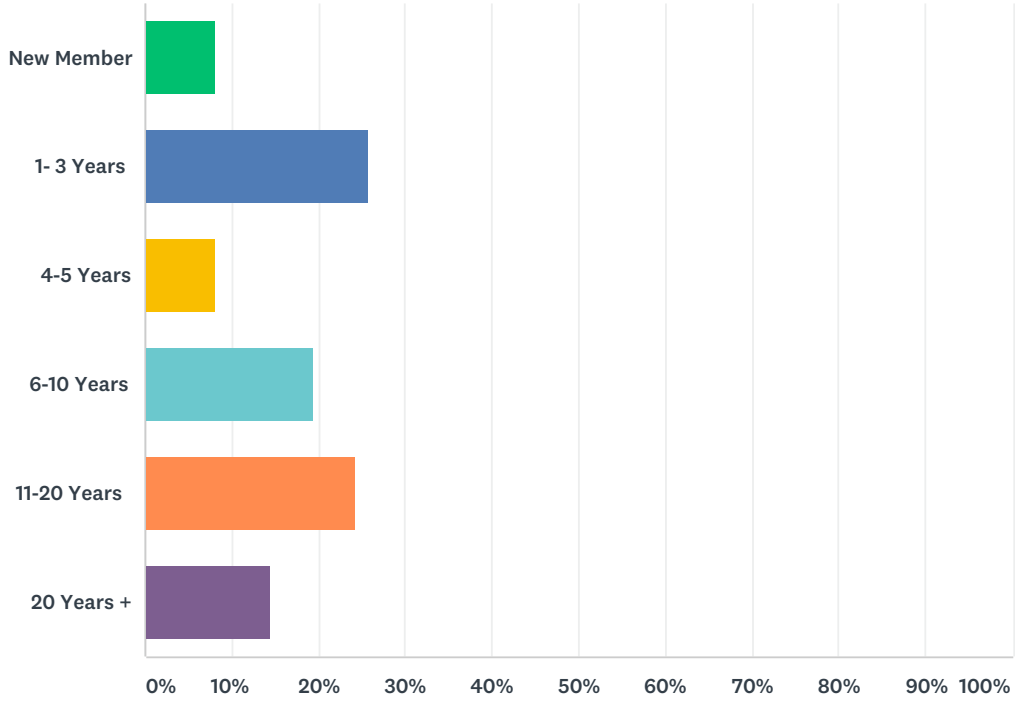


Q1 How long have you been a member of FLAEYC?

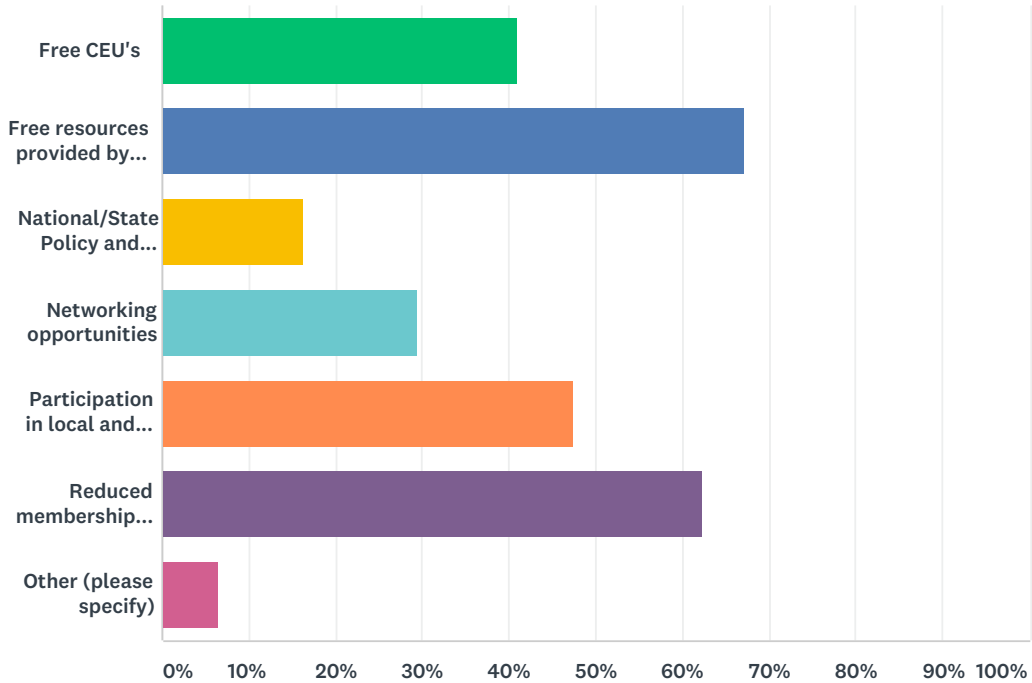

Q2 Which current membership benefits do you utilize?

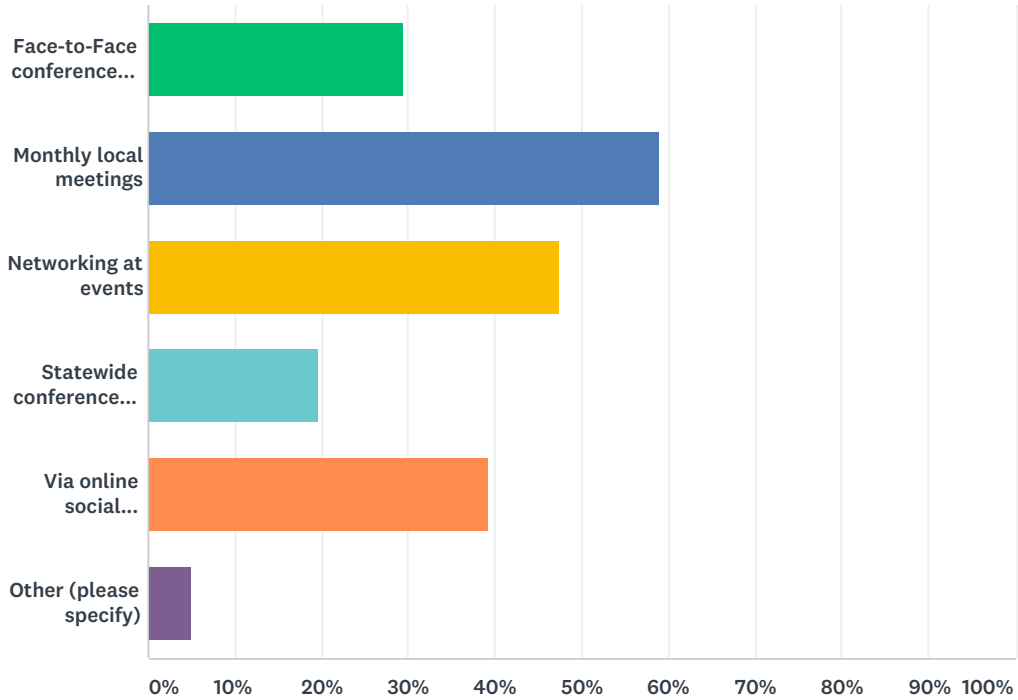

Q4 Related to Chapter participation (both local and statewide) how do you prefer to meet and get to know other members?

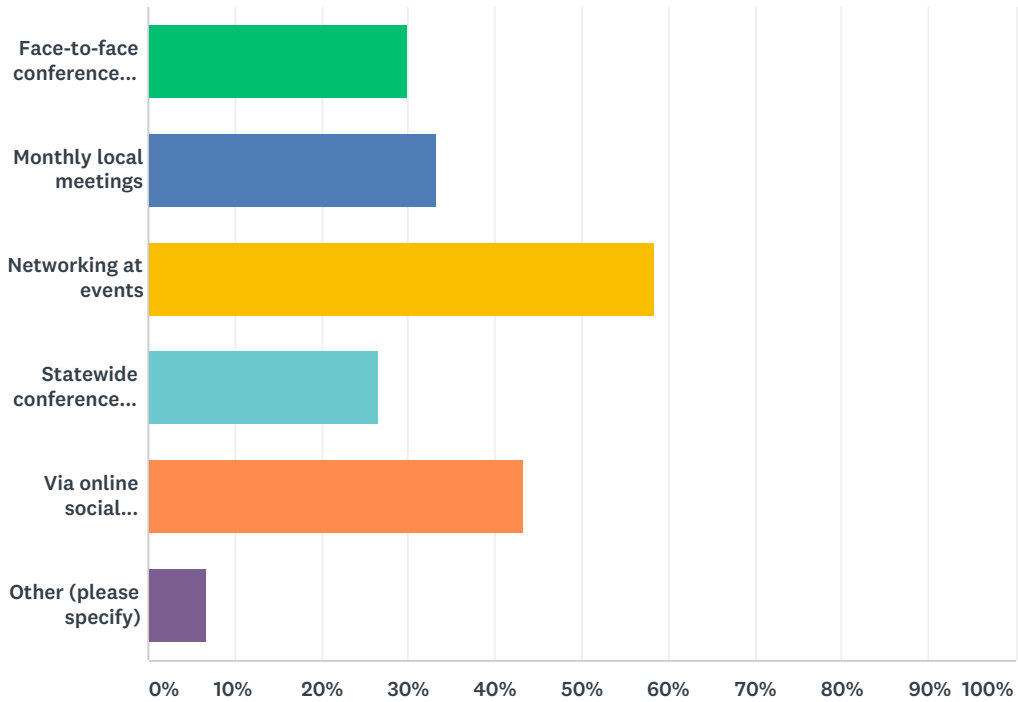

Q5 Related to FLAEYC membership, on a statewide basis, how do you prefer to meet and get to know other members?

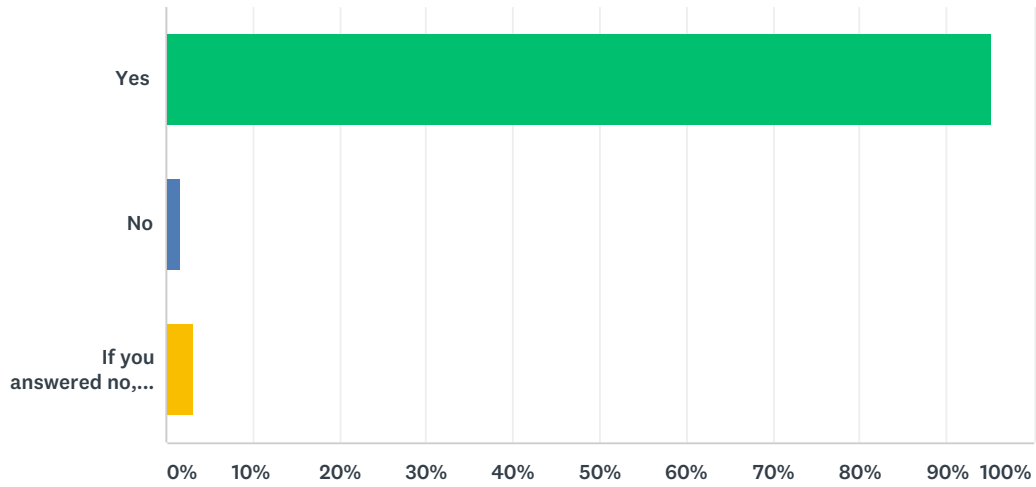

Q6 Is a monthly electronic newsletter an effective way for you to keep in touch with FLAEYC regarding upcoming events and activities?

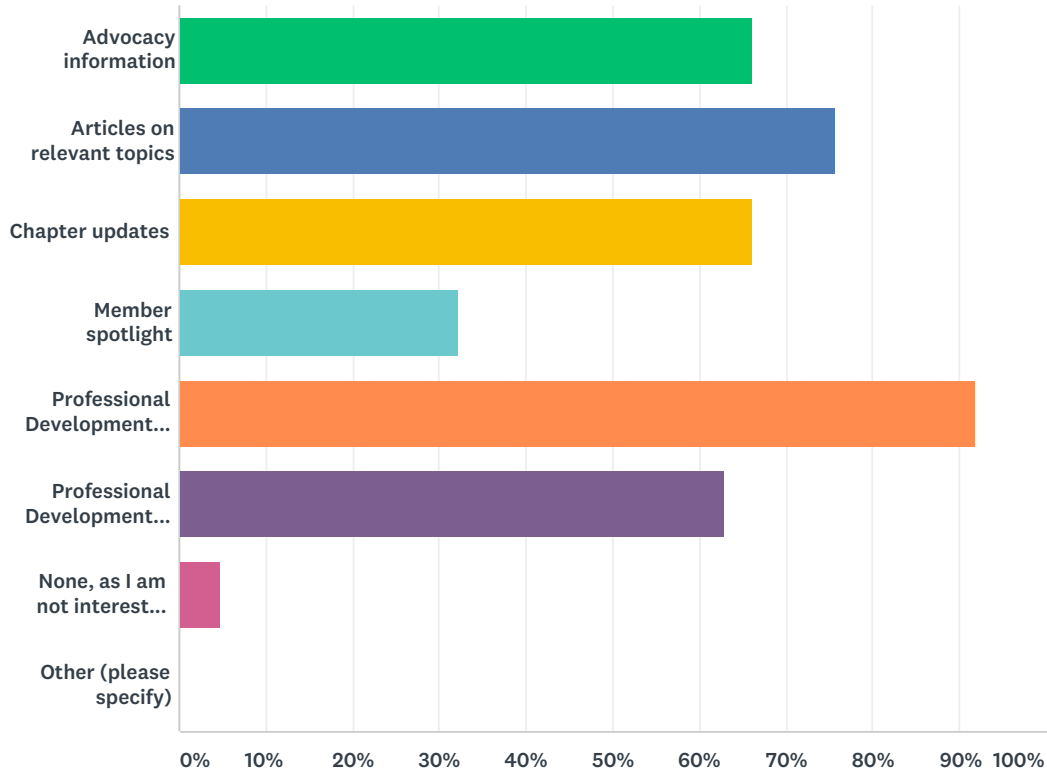

Q7 What type of content would you like to see in a FLAEYC Newsletter?

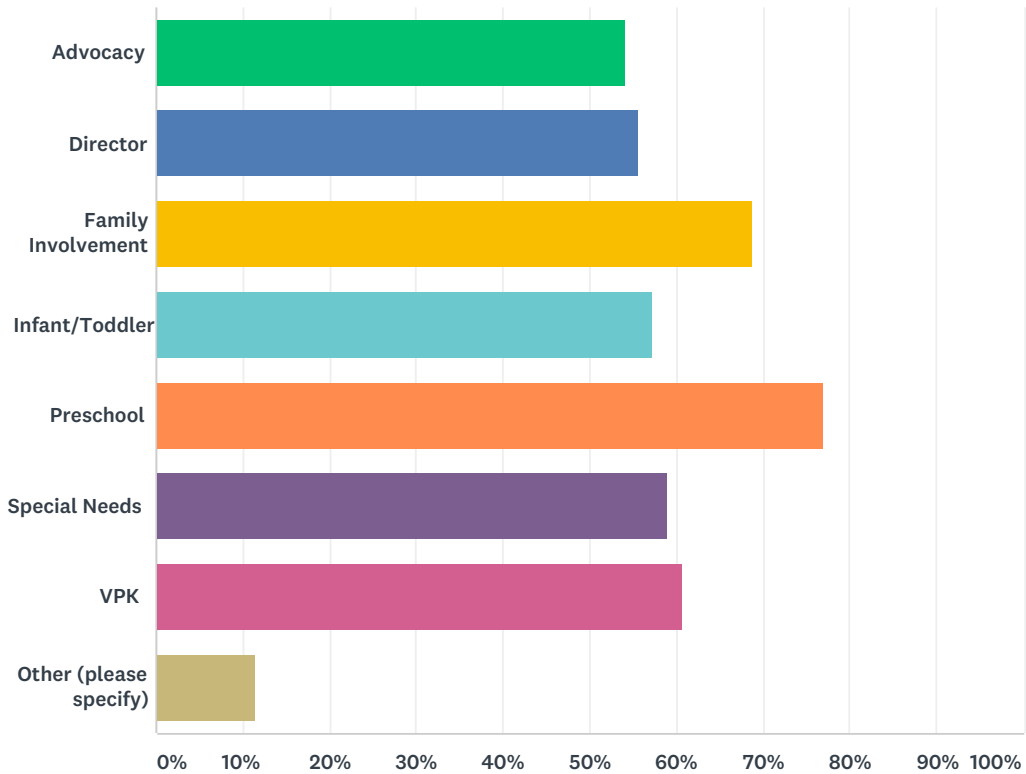

Q8 Specific to articles on relevant topics, what topics interest you?

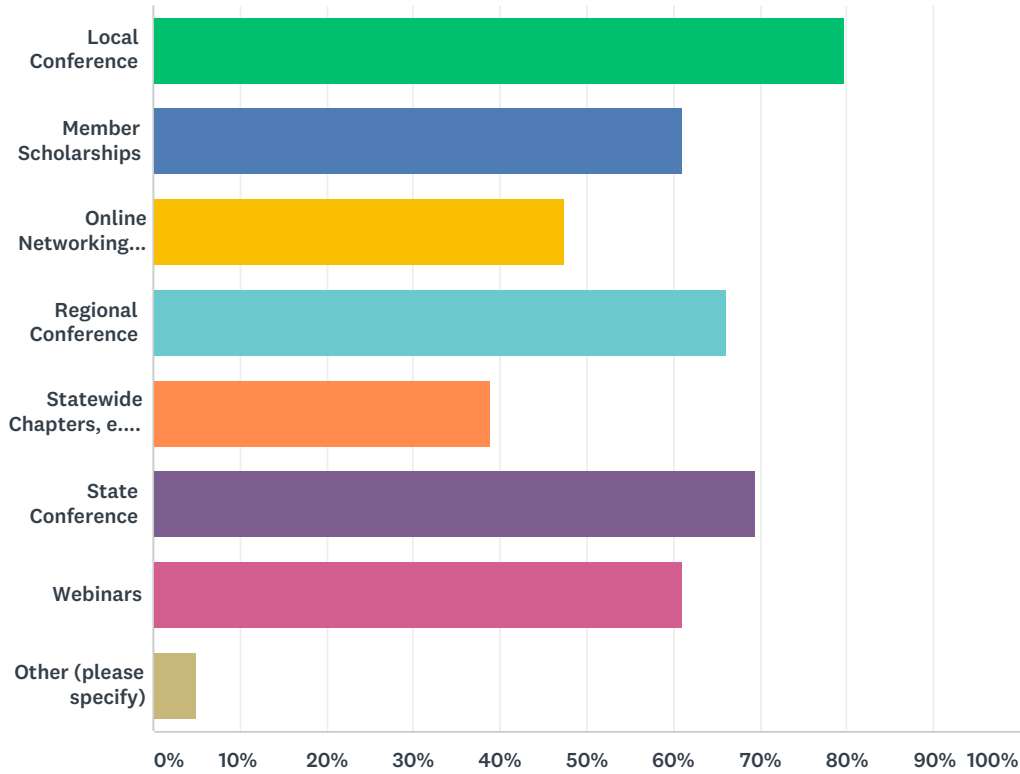

Q9 What type of events should FLAEYC provide?

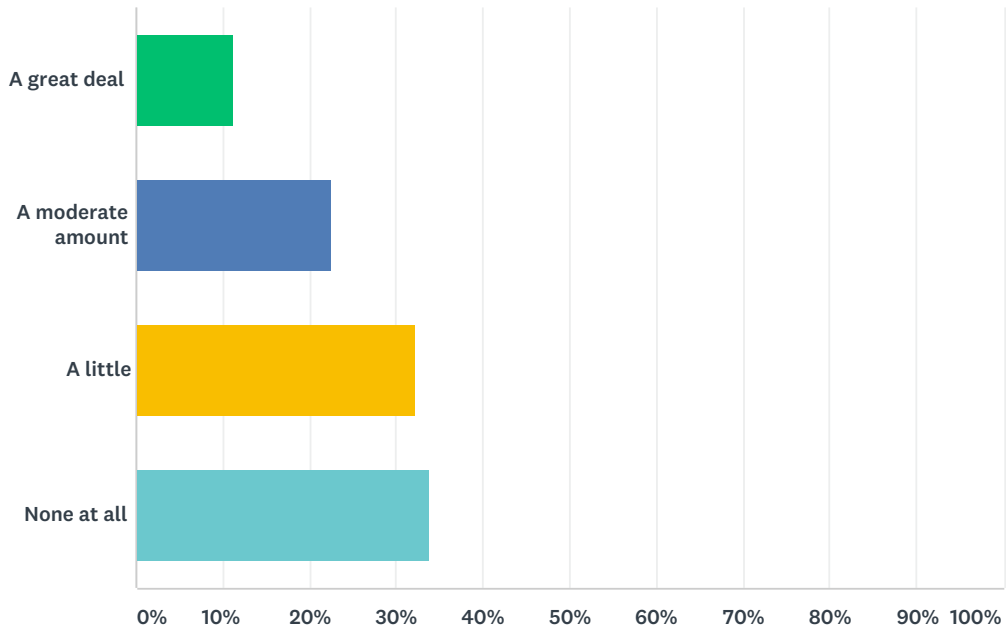

Q10 Do you follow us on social media?

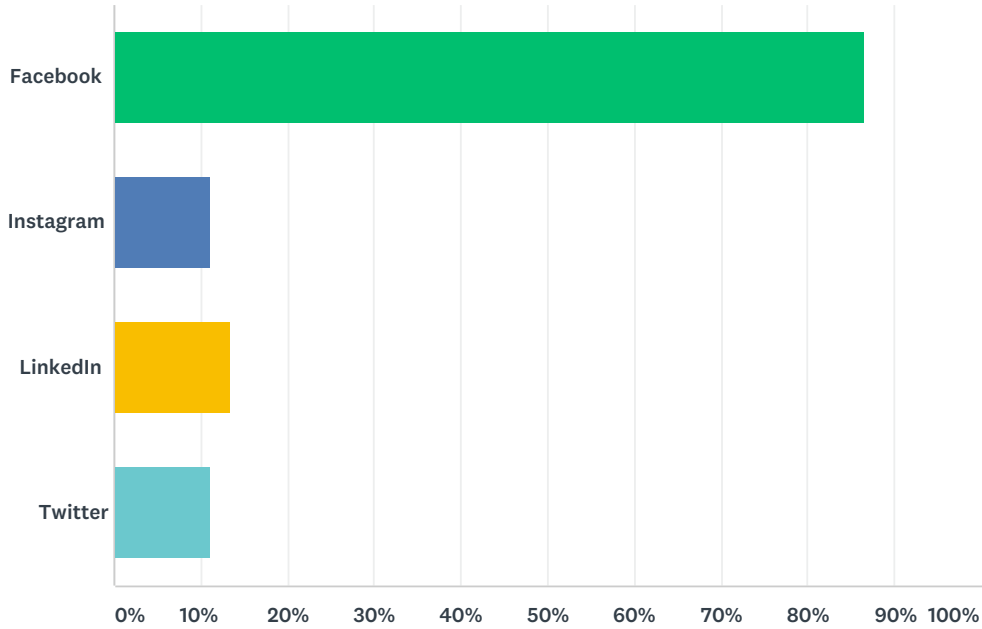

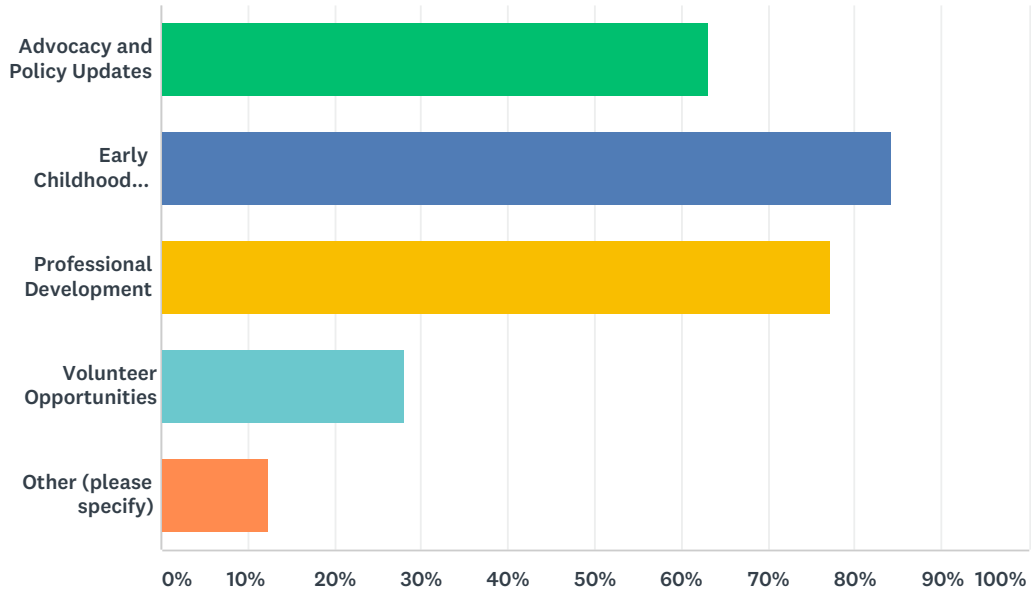

Q12 What would you like to see us post about on social media?

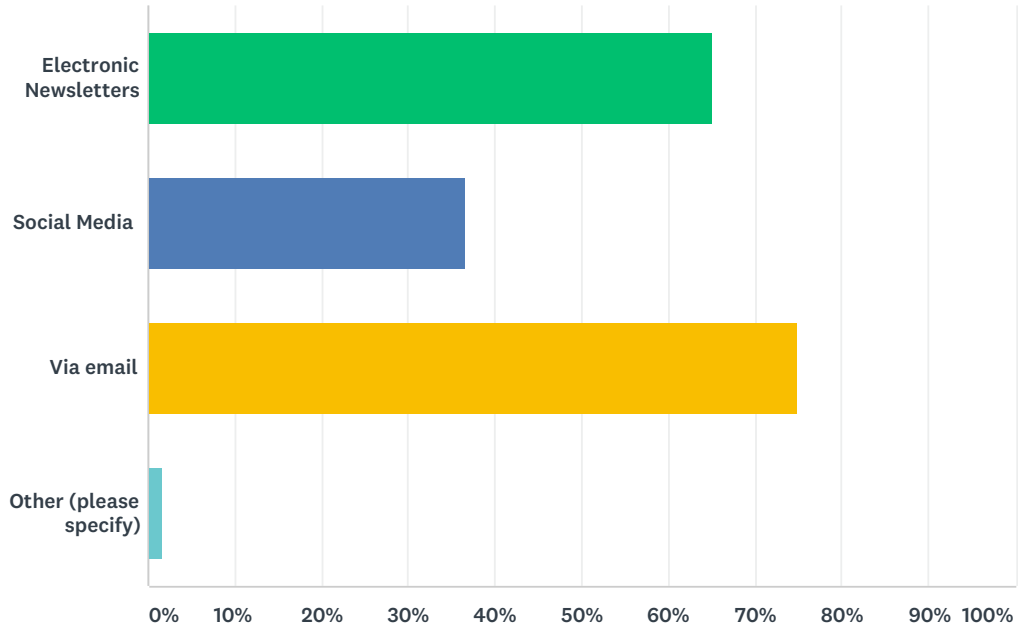

Q13 How do you prefer to receive news/announcements from FLAEYC?

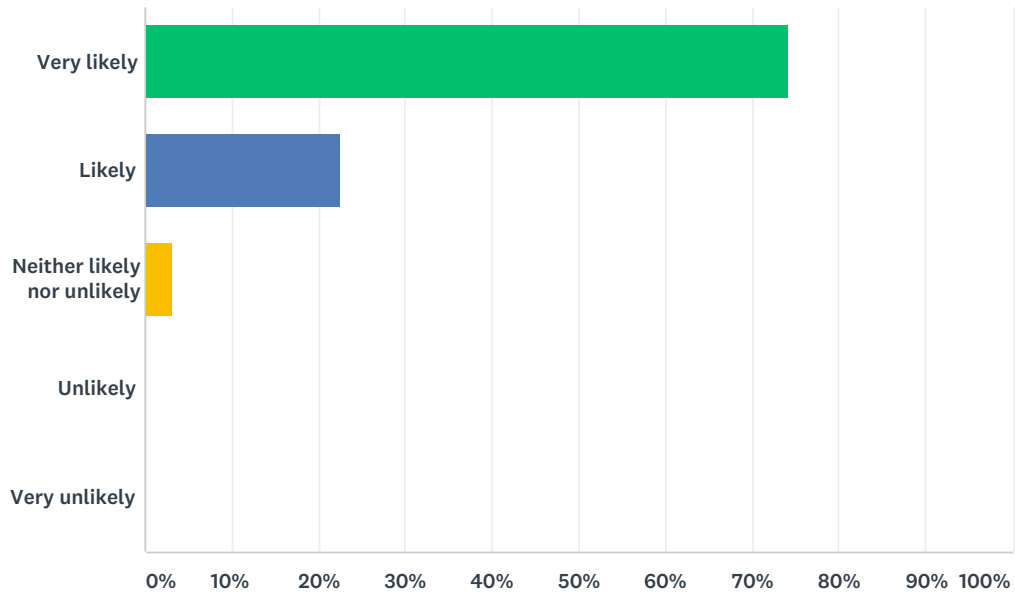
